



## After reinstalling the system the battery is not the original one

In Windows 10, do this through Settings > Update & Security > Troubleshoot > Power > Run the troubleshooter. Windows 11 troubleshooter's are in Settings > ...

Running the battery check in HP Hardware Diagnostics returned an error, and Support Assistant reports no battery present. On rebooting there's a BIOS-level warning that the battery is not charged ...

Whether your laptop is not detecting the battery or battery is detected but it is not getting charged, discharging the capacitors can ...

Description of issue: I bought my notebook on february, 2016 in the US. I recently decided to replace the battery because it did not hold the charge too much time and I bought an original spare part from a HP retailer. However, the notebook did not recognize the new battery; it does not work without the Ac Adapter connected to it.

Make sure the battery you bought has the negative and positive terminals on the proper ends of the battery (see illustration). Note that just because the battery looks the same in every other way doesn't ...

Lots of new cars will block everything once you disconnect the battery. And when you install the new one or reinstall the old recharged battery, it may just fail to work correctly. old is the battery that is dangling on the shelf). It's good maintenance practice to replace the CMOS battery about every 3 years to ensure it is strong enough in voltage to retain the CMOS settings. You typically have about 1, or maybe 2, minutes to put in a new battery after removing the old one before the charge drains off the CMOS chip.

If the battery icon is missing from the Taskbar on Windows 11, the battery driver might be disabled or uninstalled on your system. Check this in the Device Manager and troubleshoot accordingly.

You can bring your laptop and batteries to after-sale service to test if the battery is broken. If they are broken, you need to replace the batteries.

Generally, if you can't get the original straight from the device manufacturer, it may be a better idea to pick a
