

Battery has gone to sleep. If a lithium battery hits absolute 0% a normal charger won"t pick it up, I suspect the power supply is bypassing the battery and just powering the laptop. If you take it to a battery shop they could connect it ...

If you plug your laptop"s power adapter into a power socket while the battery is in the laptop, the battery icon on the Windows 10 or Windows 11 taskbar should normally show that it"s charging. But if you ...

Battery is always at 0% so I assumed that the problem is not the battery itself otherwise it would always charge even if just a few percent, wouldn"t hold that charge for long but would charge. Although I"ve read somewhere where that battery management can" stop the battery from charging to avoid damage.

There could be several reasons for your Windows laptop to show "0% available, plugged in but not charging." Here are a few possible causes and solutions: 1. Faulty charging cable or adapter: Check if the charging cable or power adapter is damaged. Try using a different cable or adapter to see if that resolves the issue. 2.

Remove the battery and disconnect the AC. Hold the power switch down for 60 seconds. Connect the battery (no AC yet) and power on. The PC is now running on battery. Connect the AC. It started charging! Note: connecting the battery before the AC seemed to do the trick.

The laptop instantly powers off when the official Microsoft 65w charger is removed. The problem is being unable to operate on battery power and/or charging the battery.

It says "0% available (on power, battery is not charging)". The power led is blinking amber, which means according to the manual that "The battery has a charge of 20% or less and the AC power adapter is connected to the computer." I tried another AC plug, plugging the battery in and out and rebooting Windows without any effect.
