Buy a battery with at least 850 "cold cranking amps" if you live in a cold climate. This helps your car start more easily in freezing temperatures. Choose a battery with a reserve capacity of at least 150 minutes. This allows your battery to deliver a minimum amount of power for at least 150 minutes before dying.
