



Battery still consumes power even when the power is turned off

As we keep mentioning, modern appliances often don't turn off even if you've hit their OFF button. They keep drawing electricity because instead of completely powering down, they go into idle mode. You can expect your washing machine to use standby power if you don't pull the plug off the socket.

The reason why your laptop battery drains even when off is that your laptop may wake up even with the lid down. Hibernation features and other faulty settings can cause this issue. Here's how to fix it:

I've contacted with lenovo and they says that if the Fast Startup option is enabled, this is the cause of discharging the battery because even when laptop is off, Fast startup requires power.

When computer is power-off it drains about 30% every 6-9 hours. It seems like the computer never has turned

off and is still working (and discharging the battery). It occurs when either the computer is sleeping or powered-off. The battery has a normal condition of 92%.

It won't be a significant amount, but yes it will consume a small amount of electricity even if the machine is off. The battery slowly loses charge and has to be replenished, some chargers have lights on them that use a small amount of energy, etc.

The battery drains even when the PC is turned off. The battery has discharged when I turn on the computer a few days after a full charge. I bought the new computer 3 weeks ago and from the first moment I notice that it consumes battery power when turned off (not suspended, not - 9171275 ... They are all drawing power EVEN WHEN LAPTOP IS TURNED OFF. You can disable these devices using the device manager as explained in step 1 here .

In fact, I'm certain that when I turned it off, it had at least 80% battery left. After over a week of sitting there completely off I couldn't power it up today at all. I plugged it in and it turns out that it lost ALL power and had to charge to at ...

Battery drains while computer is completely off and often have to hold the power button down for 8 seconds for the laptop to turn on. Turned it on this morning and the laptop had dropped to about 20% when it was 100% and turned off the night before. I have reset the BIOS, done a clean install of windows 10, and tried pulling the battery.

Turning off Wi-Fi before shutting the Mac down. all to no avail. Weirdly enough, if I just sleep the Mac, the

drain was normal (just 1% drain overnight). Shut down, which was not supposed to drain any battery, was actually draining A LOT (even if need power for startup or shut down, those maybe drain around 1-5%, not 20%).

When you close your Windows laptop lid, the Sleep mode kicks in, consuming minimal power to keep the laptop awake. This will drain your laptop's battery if unattended for ...

For some reason, most of my battery power plans had deep sleep enabled, RTC wake timers enabled, etc. Things I thought I turned off years ago apparently didn't work. You must make the changes directly through Quick CPU to get into the registry, all those other command line changes or check boxes don't do much of anything. Quick CPU overrides it ...

@Mehrdad G3 is only when the hard power switch (if you even have one) is off or if the system is unplugged from the wall and the batteries (if any, if they're even removable) are removed. Normal "soft-off" (can be woken by electronic means like a soft power switch, and maybe WoL/alarm/etc.) is S5/G2 and also has a "very low" power consumption.

iPad battery drains even when iPad is turned off Recently my 2nd gen. iPad drains the whole battery for no reason. I charge it up, turn it off and don't use for a couple of days. After two days it won't even turn on, because the battery has been drained completely. I read that this was a common issue of an iOS upgrade.

It's also a new form of hibernation known as hybrid sleep -- and this causes battery drain to maintain the state of the PC while turned off. In some rare cases, it can also cause a laptop to overheat because the processor is still running and still generating heat, as this has been reported when the laptop was turned off and put inside a case.
