Why Does a Motherboard Have a Battery? ... Once you finish this step, screw the panel back onto the computer and attach your battery and power cord. If the system works fine, you fixed the problem. Not all batteries have a motherboard, which means that sometimes the above method will not work.

Windows has many "advanced power settings" you can adjust.
