To prevent fires from lithium-ion batteries, tape battery terminals and/or place batteries in separate plastic bags and never put these batteries in household garbage or recycling bins.

Household hazardous waste (HHW) is any waste material that is a threat to human health or harm to the environment if not disposed of properly. Most products labeled dangerous, flammable, poison, combustible and corrosive are considered hazardous waste. ... Universal waste regulations do not require shipment using a hazardous waste manifest but do require that the waste be sent to a permitted hazardous waste disposal facility or a recycler. International shipments of Li-ion batteries managed as universal waste must also comply with RCRA requirements for export and import of universal waste .

The battery may be RCRA hazardous waste if it exhibits a characteristic of hazardous waste (D001 -- ignitability, D002 -- corrosivity, D003 -- reactivity, or D004 to D043 -- toxicity). For example, if the battery is damaged or leaking, the battery is likely considered hazardous waste and subject to specific regulations for proper disposal.

Many types of batteries, regardless of size, exhibit hazardous characteristics and are considered hazardous waste when discarded. A discarded battery that exhibits a hazardous waste characteristic or contains a listed hazardous waste, as described in the California Code of Regulations, title 22, chapter 11, is subject to regulation under California's:
