5.2 Complying with Battery Import Laws. To comply with battery import laws, you may need to obtain permits or certifications from relevant authorities in your country. These could include UN38.3 certification for lithium batteries or Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) for certain battery chemistries.

You do not need to pay import VAT unless the value of your shipment exceeds \$800 - this threshold applies per package even if there are multiple items in one box. You should expect additional state taxes that depend



on where your goods are coming from or heading to, as each state has different rates ranging from 0 to 2 percent.
