Unplug your Base Station from power by removing the power cable from the bottom of it. Use a Philips head



screwdriver to remove the security screw, underneath where the power cable was. Next, remove the battery cover from the bottom of the Base Station to expose the batteries. Remove the old batteries

If you have a Ring Alarm Pro, start by unplugging the cables from the back of any attached power packs and the Base Station itself. Step 2: Unplug the Main Power Cord: Never remove the Base Station battery while it's still connected to power. Make sure to unplug the main power cord first. Step 3: Locate Battery Screw Hole:

Install your Base Station Make sure the power outlet is not controlled by a light switch which could accidentally cut power to the Base Station. Your Base Station's LED light indicates the status of the system. Blue means it's armed, no light means it's disarmed. Place your Base Station in a central location in your house.

Adjust the base stations so that the front panels are facing toward the center of the play area. Attach the power cables to the base stations, and then plug them each into a power outlet to turn them on. The status lights should be green. Connect the base stations and set the channels.

The BC9180(TM) base station, when paired with one or more PowerScan(TM) 9500 readers, builds a Cordless Reading System for the collection, decoding and transmission of bar code data. It can be connected to a Host PC via Ethernet Host Interface. The BC91x0 models also provide a spare battery charger slot.

Not all stations work with all laptops. Plug your computer and your keyboard, mouse, and other peripherals into the docking station. Be sure the docking station is receiving power and that you are using the power cord that was specifically made for your station.

Plug the USB upstream cable into the upstream port on the monitor and a USB 3.0 port on your PC. If you want to connect peripherals as well, connect them to the downstream ports on the monitor. Connect the power cable to the connector on the monitor and the wall outlet. Reconnect your PC''s power cable as well. Power on your PC and enjoy.
