

Installing A New Battery. Installing a new car battery is a relatively quick and straightforward process once you have removed the old battery. Before installation, be sure to clean out the holding tray and the positive and negative cables before inserting the new battery into the tray.

Step 4: Take a Photo of the Battery to Find Out Its Type Once you locate the CMOS battery, take a photo of it to find out its type.
