When vehicles occupy both stalls for a single V2 Supercharger cabinet, the power is divided between the two vehicles. Charging your laptop stops battery saver. Another way to turn off the battery saver is to click or tap the battery icon in the bottom-right corner of your desktop. In the panel that pops up, you should find the slider on the left edge of the Power mode bar. Move the slider to the right, to any other position, and the battery saver is disabled.
