



# How to turn off the sound of the solar thermostat

Try turning the breaker off for 1 min, then back on, then turn the thermostat back on. If that doesn't work, you can try to reset the thermostat. Or, just upgrade to the new Touchscreen or WiFi TouchScreen. Thermostats ship same day ...

**Turn Off The Geyser** - Start the procedure by turning off the appliance first. **Locate The Thermostat** - The next step is to locate the thermostat in the geyser. The device is usually visible in such models. **Change The Settings** - Turn or rotate the thermostat knob to adjust the temperature settings to the desired number.

If you want, for example, to turn off a thermostat Honeywell, you can often do so through the different Modes that the thermostat has available. Usually, there's a Cool, Heat, and Auto mode. The Off option is normally included there. This rings true for more advanced thermostats like the ones manufactured by Nest.

Choose the temperature setting you want to adjust (e.g., heating or cooling) and turn the option Off. For a Nest Thermostat, adjust the daily Eco settings and turn them off individually. From the Nest Thermostat. You can also disable the Eco Temperature function from the Nest Thermostat display: Access the main Menu (tap the icon with wavy lines).
