Solar Panel Ladder has been designed to offer a safe, practical way of working when installing or maintaining solar panel arrays. Bridging ladder provides 23 cm clearance from the roof to the underside of the stile, allowing plenty of work space, and up to 4.6 m free span over the roof.

I was able to lift and install all 7 385w panels on the roof by myself. The design shown in the video was unchanged. I think the most critical thing to realize is that you should test your setup before you hoist a live panel. I used a plywood as a "test panel" with the approximate dimensions as my Hanwa 385w panels. The ply wood was heavier ...
