

The 24 Solar Terms, or (èr shí sì jiéqì), is a traditional Chinese calendar system that divides the year into 24 periods, each lasting about two weeks. The ...

The Chinese calendar - like the Hebrew - is a combined solar/lunar calendar in that it strives to have its years coincide with the tropical year and its months coincide with the synodic months. It is not surprising that a few similarities exist between the Chinese and the Hebrew calendar: An ordinary year has 12 months, a leap year has 13 months.

The Chinese calendar is a lunar-solar dating system used in China and neighboring countries. It consists of 12 months of alternately 29 and 30 days, equal to 354 days. In popular practice, each year in a 12-year cycle corresponds to an animal in the Chinese zodiac.

The Chinese zodiac animals were assigned months on the traditional Chinese solar calendar. Each animal sign corresponds with two of the 24 solar terms, for a period similar to a Western zodiac month. This means that the Western astrological signs and Chinese zodiac months have a half-month overlap, as can be seen in the diagram right.

Chinese 24 Solar Terms. The Chinese people divided a year into 24 segments based on the sun"s position in the zodiac. Each segment is called a "jié qì", solar term. means "segment" in Chinese. refers to the climate or the seasons. There are 2 solar terms in each of the 12 months, with each segment lasting around 15 days.
